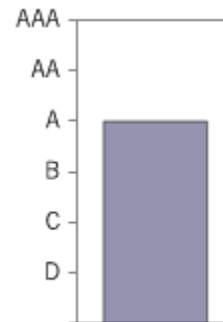

CareScout Historical State Rating

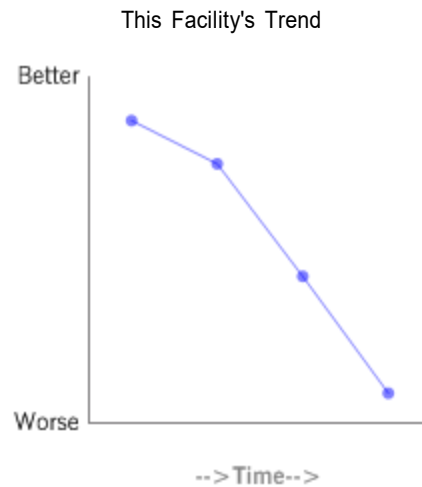

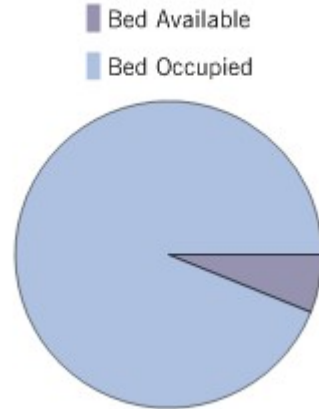

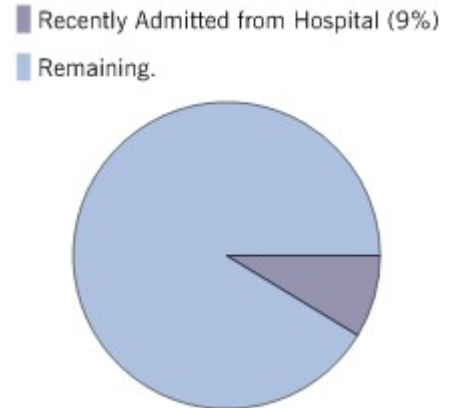

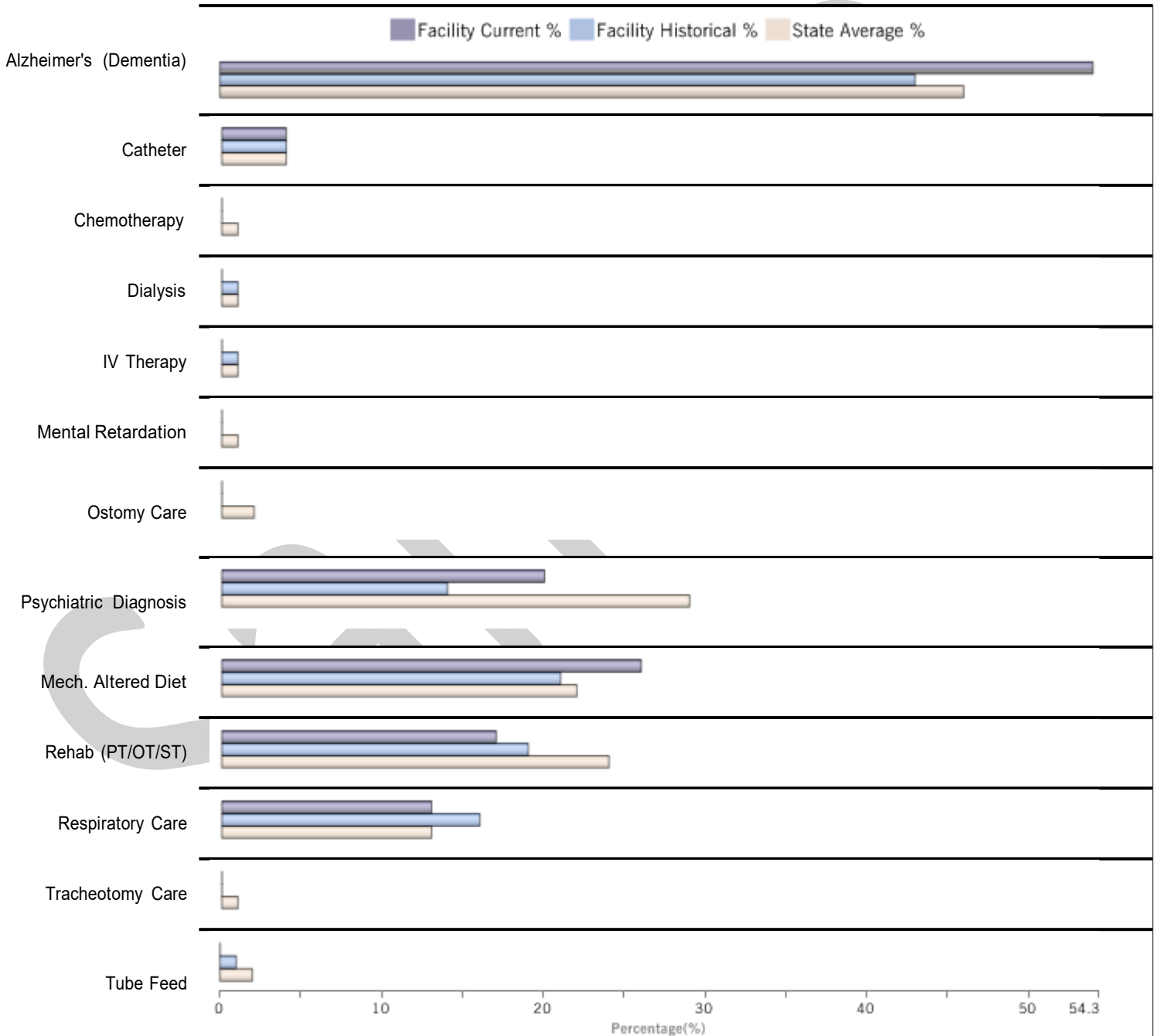

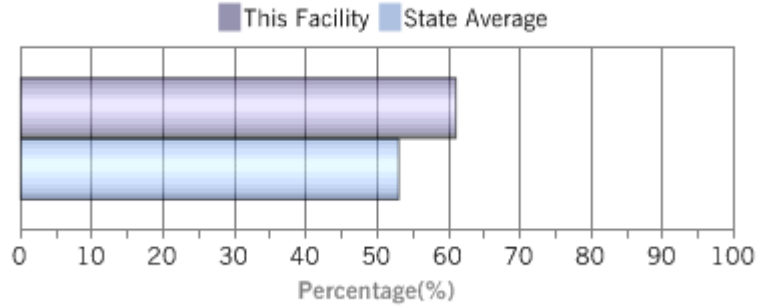

Medicaid Population

Residents who cannot afford the costs and expenses associated with nursing home care often receive Medicaid support. Compared with other facilities state-wide, this facility's Medicaid population percentage is Above Average, with 61% receiving Medicaid assistance. The state average is 53%.

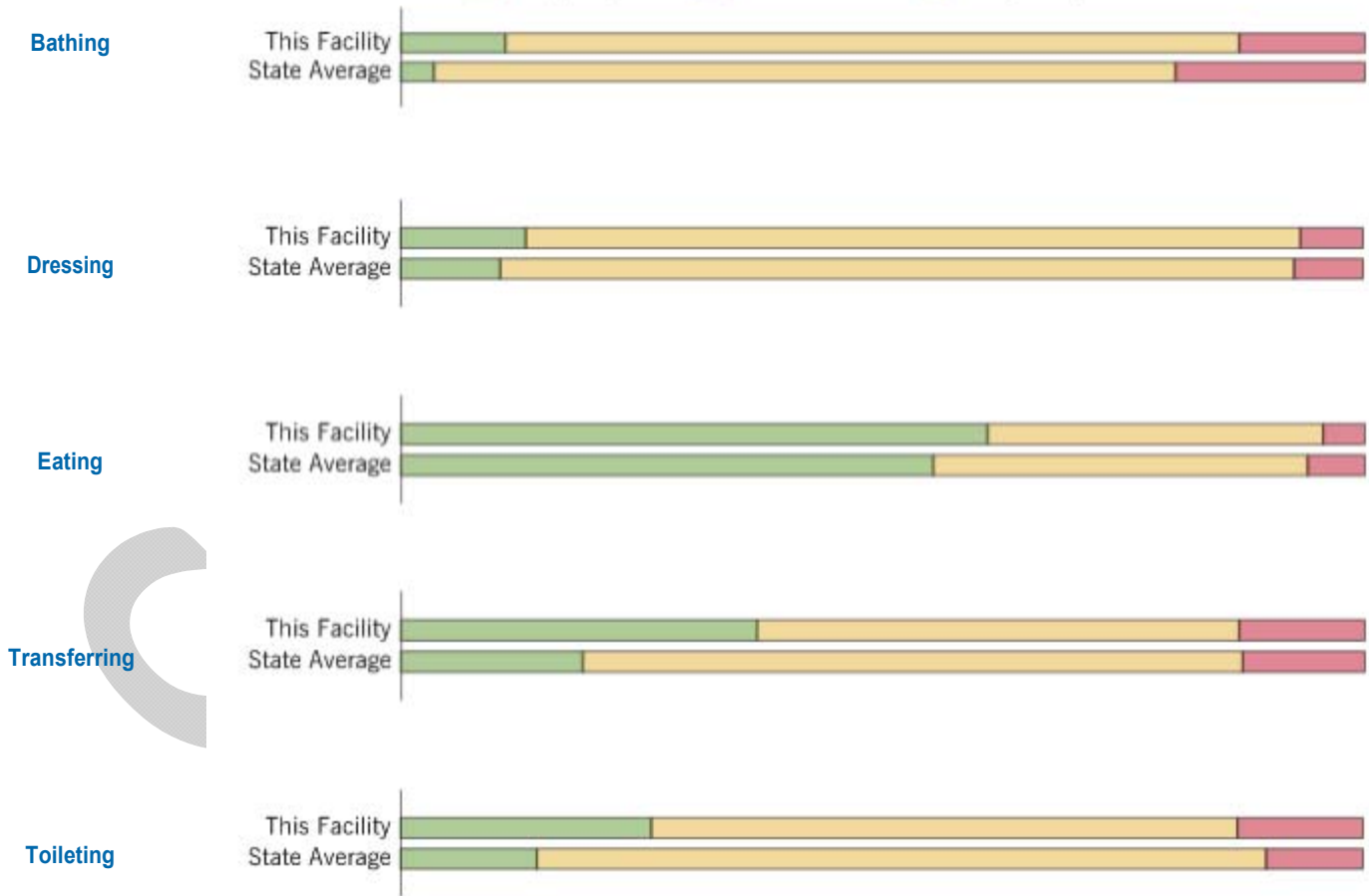
IV. Resident Abilities
